The Chickasaw Cultural Center is located in Sulphur, Oklahoma near the Chickasaw National Recreation Area. Its 109-acre campus is home to historical museums with interactive exhibits on Chickasaw tribal history, traditional dancing, and Chickasaw language. Within this facility you can find a Genealogy

Archive Center, the Center for Study of Chickasaw History and Culture, an Aaholiitobli' Honor Garden and the Chickasaw Cultural Center Art Galleries.

Arriving from the west (I-35):

1. Take exit 55 for OK-7 toward Davis.
2. Head east on OK-7 (signs for Oklahoma School) for 10 miles.
3. Turn right onto Cooper Memorial Rd, head south for about 1 mile.
4. The entrance road to the Cultural Center will be on your left-hand side after you pass the RV park.

Arriving from the east (Sulphur, OK):

1. Head west on OK-7.
2. Turn left onto Cooper Memorial Rd (Pass by the McDonalds on the left).
3. Head south for about 1 mile.
4. The entrance road to the Cultural Center will be on your left-hand side after your pass the RV park.
