Given the pervasiveness of human rights abuses and the context of impunity often enjoyed by corporations, international avenues towards accountability are critical.

Examining cases where human rights due diligence has failed, key considerations for due diligence in indigenous areas, and domestic legal actions taken by indigenous communities, panelists will offer recommendations on how to ensure respect and protection of human rights in the context of business activities.
